- One (1) page handwritten or typed essay, including information about yourself, your goals in life, and any agricultural related goals.

It is recommended that applications be reviewed by the Counselor before mailing.

Applications <u>MUST</u> be mailed and postmarked by April 15,2024. E-mailed, faxed, or hand-delivered applications will **not** be accepted for consideration under any circumstances. Incomplete applications and applications postmarked after the deadline also will **not** receive consideration.
